DIFFERENT LETTERS / GROUPS OF DIFFERENT LETTERS IN THE DIFFERENT WORDS OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE, BEGINNING WITH THE ALPHABETS 'A', 'B, ' AND 'C' HAVING THE SAME PRONUNCIATION

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Abstract
